

## 2020 LEADINGAGE OHIO PAC YEAR-IN-REVIEW

#### A CHALLENGING YEAR LED TO CREATIVE NEW PAC EVENTS AND RECORD PAC DONATIONS.

The LeadingAge Ohio Political Action Committee (PAC) supports lawmakers who have demonstrated commitment to and understanding of issues important to older Ohioans, their caregivers, and the communities that serve them. LeadingAge Ohio's PAC does not distinguish its support on the basis of political party. In recent years, LeadingAge Ohio has grown its PAC exponentially, taking steps to better use the PAC as a tool to strengthen advocacy and grassroots efforts.

Building on a strong 2019 in which the LeadingAge Ohio PAC raised over \$20,000 for the first time ever, a \$30,000 fundraising goal was set for 2020. As with so many other bestlaid plans in 2020, COVID-19 forced the PAC to step back and re-assess. **The PAC goal was shifted to \$15,000, as the in-person events the PAC has traditionally relied upon would prove difficult or impossible.** 

This shift to virtual and outdoor events, and the lack of an in-person annual conference, led to some unexpected but welcome advances in the growth of our PAC. The first-ever LeadingAge Ohio PAC golf outing was able to be held safely and completely outdoors on a sunny Monday in October. In addition, LeadingAge Ohio organized its first-ever virtual wine tasting series with Keplinger Wines, giving members an opportunity to sample some magnificent wine out of Napa Valley. In addition to these two successful events, the LeadingAge Ohio Board and Staff joined together to challenge each other to reach 100% participation in PAC. The efforts of our Board, Partners, PAC supporters, and staff combined to help the PAC reach its highest-ever amount raised - blowing past the \$15,000 goal to exceed \$26,000.
